

A Hazard: Collision with moving vehicles	
Who can be harmed/how?	Controls in place
All Staff, Contractors, Members of the Public  Route to course is via the car park.	Pootpaths Clear routes to the activity and pedestrian crossings.

Hazard: Hit by Stray Golf Ball	
Who can be harmed/how?	Controls in place
